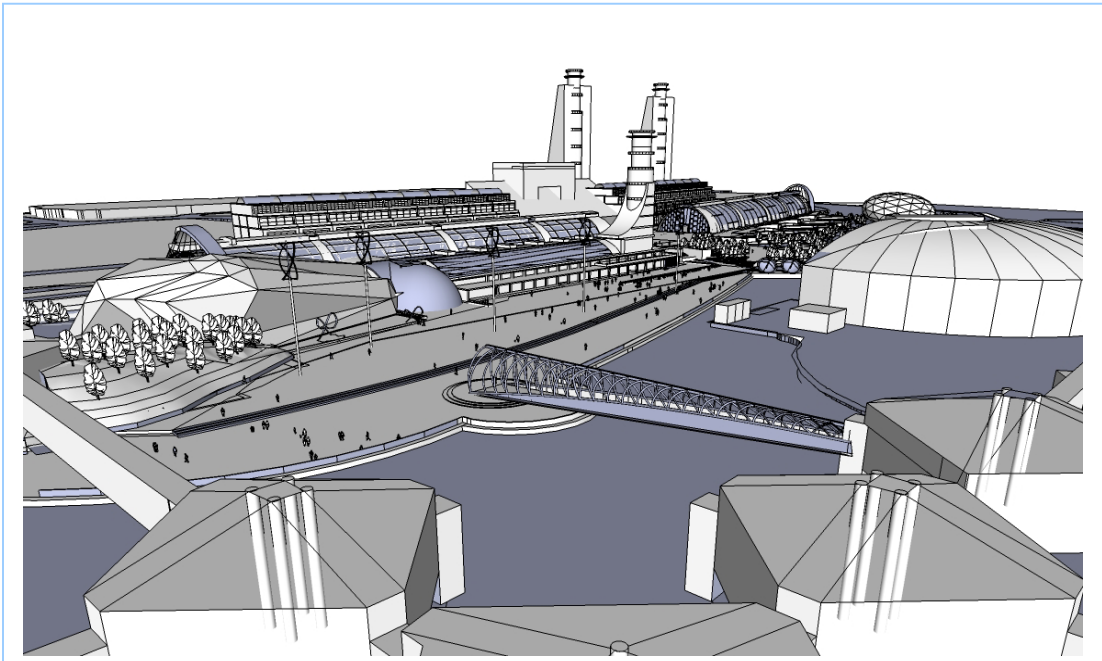

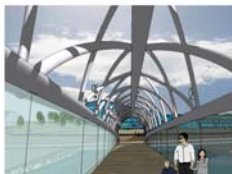

A transformative proposal for the Toronto Western Waterfront

- **OTERE is about Canada's role as an Energy and Transportation Technology Leader. It is an urban planning proposal designed to highlight the full range of potential technologies to be developed on the site of Toronto's iconic Ontario Place. The ultimate purpose for GWPT is to coordinate an integrated renewable energy system and design analysis for feasibility purposes in order to create an advanced green revitalization of one of this province's and country's most important waterfront sites.**
- **Specifically OTERE is proposed to be part of a collaboration of national interest between the City, the Province and private stakeholders with an open competition proposal call goal of 2010. The timing is right for an integrated planning approach given the recent announcement in February, 2009 within the Provincial report on Tourism 'Discovering Ontario' stating that a Canadian Sesquicentennial celebration showpiece is being considered for the site. The underlying theme of OTERE is to insure that an advanced energy system and transportation hub is put in place that reflects current knowledge in conservation, renewable energy production and value capture logistics. While providing a major contribution to the feasibility process OTERE recognizes the need to provide direction in a fast emerging era of energy and climate responsibility.**
- **'Water West', a proposed name for this 6 hectare land reclamation scheme for the North side of Ontario Place and the South CNE lands will be a new waterfront amenity destination while accommodating existing and future local developments. This sustainable planning, construction, and transportation proposal includes: retail markets, hotel(s), botanical gardens and raised greenhouses, educational attractions including a library and research centre, a waterfront promenade and exhibition space. Through local food and renewable energy production, conservation, micro-waste conversion and on-site recycling a massive CARBON- ADVANTAGE demonstration is anticipated to gain international attention.**



- **The repair of lands is proposed to take the physical form of a 'connection system' between the CNE and Ontario Place with a hybrid bridge proposal that takes advantage of the air rights above the Lakeshore Boulevard while fully integrating the two recreation areas. The conversion of a series of unsightly parking lots and roadways now in the middle of highly valued land will demonstrate a timely and coordinated focus for the Province and the City. Sketches of the potential land uses for Water West have been created to prompt the interest of the general public, private stakeholders, as well as government leaders and to focus the potentials of GWPT participation defined in the full OTERE Proposal.**
